Ferry Timetable

The September ferry timetable poster has been created and has been placed in the council's noticeboards for residents.

Micks Garage

Northwest Electricity completed their inspection of the site on the 17th of July, and it has passed to have the electricity connected. The timetable for installing the electric is as follows:

Excavation / Digging – 4th September

Proposed Jointing – 7th September

Latest date for completion – 14th September

BT joinery is to start work week commencing 21st September

Unity Bank Card

The card is now up and running to be used. I have also opened an Amazon Business account for the council and updated the council's policies accordingly.

Electricity Installed at Kelly's Corner, and the Cenotaph

The electric points have now been installed, and the licence is to be paid within September's finances. The assistant clerk is co-ordinating with the local electrician PRS to allow for the electric points to be used for the equipment's plugs.

Planters for Entrance Signs to the Town

The self-watering planters are now in situ and planted up at the welcome signs held at Cemetery Lane, and near Head Dyke Lane.

Hedges at Park Lane

The hedges have been cut by the Lengths Man, and Parrox trust has been invoiced for the work, which has now been paid in full

Meeting with the Bloomers on the 5th of September

The meeting was very productive, a full list of planting, maintenance, and watering has been produced. The plants Mans work sheet has been updated to accommodate the Bloomer's work that the legacy trust pay for. The lead Bloomer's will hand over their banking responsibilities internally within the Bloomer's group. It was agreed that the council would assist the Bloomers in raising awareness for volunteers needed to maintain the Bloomers work.
