

PREESALL TOWN COUNCIL

Minutes of the extraordinary meeting of the Town Council held on Wednesday 2 November 2022 at 6.30pm at Preesall and Knott End Youth and Community Centre

115a(1) Apologies for absence – Cllr Jepson, Cllr Pattrick, Cllr Williams. **115b(1) Absent without apology –** none.

116(2) Declaration of interests and dispensations None.

Resolved: to bring item 7 forward.

117(3) Public Bodies (Admission to Meetings) Act 1960 - Exclusion of the Press and Public

Pursuant to Section 1(2) of the Public Bodies (Admission to Meetings) Act, the council **resolved** to exclude the press and public to discuss items relating to a grant application and the co-option of town councillors.

(The press and public were excluded for the presentations on the advice received from LALC to maintain the possible confidentiality of applicants' personal details).

118(7) Consideration of grant application

Resolved: to award a grant of £250 to the Ladies of Over Wyre for their funds to purchase a projector.
